Please read our guidelines carefully as they are strictly enforced.

- **Political Campaigns, slogans and mottos are not allowed in the parade**.
- Floats will be judged prior to the parade and winners will be announced as they pass the reviewing stand.
- Please follow instructions from parade officials wearing official shirts, both in the assembly area and on the parade route.
- Assignment of position within the parade is the sole discretion of the Parade Chair. Late entries should not be surprised to be near the end of the parade.
- Do not stop in front of the reviewing stand unless you are asked to do so.
- Participants may display the name of the organization only.
- Do not hand out advertising literature.
- All animal owners will be responsible for the removal and proper disposal of animal waste throughout the parade.
- No throwing candy or other items into the crowd, for the safety of the children.
- The parade ends at Kenyon's True Value. You may exit to North Main Street into Northfield Falls OR return to the Crescent via Water Street, Wall Street and then Central Street.

Please note: Applications or phone calls for entry will not be accepted after August 23, 2024. The Northfield Observances reserves the right to refuse any application.
